The **ChBC™** is reserved for seasoned professionals with at least five years of business coaching experience, plus enough learning, positive work reports and reflective ability to meet our high assessment standards. This prestigious chartered credential tells clients, prospective clients and colleagues that you are at the pinnacle of your emerging profession.

2. Distinguish Yourself as a Business Coach

The **ChBC™** is exclusively designed for and awarded to business coaches. Business coaching is unlike any other coaching or related occupation, which is why it needs a

Because the program leading to the **ChBC™** is designed for senior business coaches, it doesn't involve lectures or coursework. Rather, it's an intensive, one-on-one coached program built around preparing a portfolio to demonstrate the depth and breadth of your professional practice.

In creating your portfolio, you'll reflect on your practice—the learning you've brought to it and gained from it, the models and ethics you adhere to, the areas where you excel and the areas where you need development. By emphasizing reflection, the **ChBC™** not only recognizes your superior practice; it *improves* that practice, taking you to a new level as a business coach.

Are You Eligible?

You can apply for the **ChBC™** if you meet the following requirements:

- You're a Full Member of WABC in good standing and have maintained all the membership standards.
- You've been actively practicing business coaching (external or internal coaching or a combination of both) for at least five years. Your CV must describe and document this established practice.

Attaining the ChBC™

To attain the **ChBC™**, you must submit a portfolio that (1) presents evidence of master-level learning and (2) reflects on and synthesizes that learning. Based on your portfolio, you'll be assigned credit for your prior learning. Prior learning includes training and education, as well as experiential learning, typically gained from professional experience.

What follows is an overview of the **ChBC™** program, which is conducted for WABC by the Professional Development Foundation (PDF) and Middlesex University. The program is described in full in the *Chartered Business Coach™ (ChBC™) Program Handbook*, while portfolio details are provided in the *Chartered Business Coach™ (ChBC™) Portfolio Guide*, both available from PDF.

Completing the ChBC portfolio—especially thinking through which learning areas to pull forward out of what feels like a vast “undergrowth” of learning—made me see myself in sharper definition as a coach. Everything feels clearer, crisper and more organized. The ChBC™ track is a rigorous process that provides experienced coaches with a wonderful opportunity to pause and consolidate their learning.

Submission Process

1. Complete the online application form and make your payment in full.
2. A PDF faculty member will interview you by phone about the program requirements and your professional development goals. If the faculty member



feels the program isn't suitable for you, you'll get full feedback and a refund of your fees.

3. Once your application is accepted, you can start preparing your portfolio. During this process, which can take up to six months, you'll have access to a range of resources:

- a dedicated learning adviser (who is also a senior coach and chartered-level professional) to give you feedback on your portfolio and let you know when it's ready to submit
- manuals that explain the program and the portfolio requirements
- a web-based learning environment
- webcasts of tutorials by PDF faculty members

Assessment Process

Your portfolio is assessed in three stages by trained assessors who meet the requirements of the ChBC™ themselves and are chartered within their own discipline.

At the first stage, one assessor reviews your portfolio, gives you a constructive critique and may ask for a dialogue. You can modify the portfolio if you wish before the second stage.

At the second stage, two assessors independently review your portfolio and make a recommendation to the Assessment Board.

At the third stage, the portfolio is awarded credit by an Assessment Board, made up of representatives from PDF and Middlesex University along with an external examiner, a senior academic specifically chosen for the task. Full credit entitles you to earn the ChBC™ credential from WABC. Partial credit entitles you to devise a learning plan to make up any shortfall, then resubmit your portfolio. You then have from one to three years to attain the credential.

Assessment Criteria

Your portfolio must show, backed by evidence, that you have reached a standard of competence as a chartered-level business coach. You may have reached this standard not only through training or professional development but also through the work you do and your reflection on the theory and experience that inform it. Your portfolio must:

- show evidence of your training and professional experience at the master level
- reflect on and synthesize your prior learning
- show evidence of competent practice
- show evidence of ethical practice



- show evidence of master-level competencies under five major themes
- describe a coherent model of your practice
- provide corroboration from others (supervisor reports, etc.)

These criteria are covered more fully in the *Chartered Business Coach™ (ChBC™) Program Handbook*.

Re-Certification

The **ChBC™** is an ongoing credential that you must renew every five years. Re-certification is strict but not onerous. You must do two things:

- remain a Full Member of WABC in good standing at all times
- show that you've kept your learning and practice up to date by submitting a record of your professional development for PDF to evaluate

Frequently Asked Questions

How is the ChBC™ designation different from or better than other credentials?

The ChBC™ is truly unique. It differs from other credentials in a number of ways:

- It's the only business coaching designation in the world at the chartered level.
- It's one in a suite of designations that WABC has created as part of its commitment to developing the “gold standard” of business coaching credentials (see next question).
- Its assessment processes are rigorous and independent. Trained assessors from PDF, a world leader in work-based professional development programs, and from Middlesex University evaluate candidates' portfolios and report their decision to WABC.
- It rewards successful candidates in two ways—with the ChBC™ designation itself, and with academic credits that can be used towards either a [Master of Arts in Professional Development \(Business Coaching\)](#) or a [Doctorate in Professional Studies \(Business Coaching\)](#), both offered by Middlesex University.

You say that WABC aspires to set the “gold standard” for business coaching credentials. What does that mean?

WABC has strived to develop the highest level—the gold standard—of business coaching credentials for coaches and their training providers. To that end, all of our



international credentials (ChBC™, CMBC®, CBC™ and WABC Accredited®) share these features:

- They are *professional* certification and accreditation credentials, the most rigorous level available in the emerging profession of business coaching. In keeping with industry best practices, these credentials require validation, carry re-certification requirements and are subject to revocation.
- They are sponsored by an international professional business coaching association (WABC).
- They focus on business coaching, not coaching in general.
- They stem from evidence-based research, including WABC's study of business coaching competencies, and were developed with a broad range of stakeholders, among them business coaches (internal and external), training bodies and client groups (businesses and other organizations).
- They are all graduate-level designations, making their standards parallel with those of established professions.
- They are linked to academic standards and protocols wherever possible, though with a focus on the practice of business coaching.
- Their assessment processes are rigorous and independent. An independent panel of expert assessors evaluates each applicant according to agreed-upon, transparent criteria, then reports the decision to WABC.
- They undergo a thorough annual review to ensure that they stay relevant and continue to set the highest international standards for business coaches and their training providers.

I already hold various credentials. Will they be accepted?

The ChBC™ assessment process recognizes your prior experience, including existing credentials and designations from WABC and other organizations. You're encouraged to include details of your credentials and training in your portfolio, so that any credit they carry can be recognized and counted towards the ChBC™ designation.

However, please bear in mind that the ChBC™ is the most advanced credential available for business coaches. While other credentials may count towards the designation, it's extremely unlikely that they will constitute full equivalence.

WABC is cooperating with other professional bodies to determine the relationships between different credentials in the field.

What are the roles of the Worldwide Association of Business Coaches, the Professional Development Foundation, Middlesex University and the International Expert Panel?

The Worldwide Association of Business Coaches is the driving force behind this advanced, rigorous credential. WABC owns the ChBC™ designation program and the



rights to the designation mark, and has the sole right to confer the designation on successful candidates.

WABC sought the expertise of the Professional Development Foundation (PDF) to research and develop this new credential, including researching the business coaching competencies on which the credential is based. As well, WABC wanted to keep assessment, administration and evaluation of the ChBC™ at arm's length to ensure that the process is independent and transparent. Therefore, PDF provides program development, administration, learning support and expert advice for the credential. Assessment is conducted jointly by PDF and Middlesex University.

Middlesex University, besides conducting assessments, provides the university credits awarded to successful candidates. It also confers the [Master of Arts in Professional Development \(Business Coaching\)](#) and the [Doctorate in Professional Studies \(Business Coaching\)](#), which are both open to holders of the ChBC™.

In the initial stages of developing the ChBC™, WABC assembled an International Expert Panel to contribute. The panelists, all senior business coaches with at least 10 years' experience, provided guidance, professional expertise and testing of the credential.

Where can I take the ChBC™ program?

Only training providers that have earned the WABC Accredited (Chartered Level)® designation are authorized to offer the ChBC™ program. At present PDF/Middlesex University is the sole training provider accredited at this level.

What's the time line for earning the credential?

Most candidates will earn their ChBC™ in three to six months, but you're allowed up to a year. If extenuating circumstances arise, you can apply for a deferment of your program at no extra charge. If you don't have a deferment and you take longer than a year to finish, you will be charged a continuation fee (25% of the original fee). This covers the cost of keeping your learning resources, including your adviser, in place for another six months while you finish the program.

How many hours does it take to complete the ChBC?

For most candidates it will take about 900 hours. This includes the time required for reading, facilitated discussion and writing.

Will client work be kept confidential?

Absolutely. The administration authorities (PDF and Middlesex University) will keep your portfolio but will not use it for anything other than evaluation or appeal purposes without your express written permission. We will never reveal your clients or others mentioned in your portfolio, or the work you've done with clients, unless we have your written permission.

As well, we acknowledge and respect academic and professional proprietary rights. We understand that the content of your portfolio belongs to you or others you have acknowledged. We will not use the content without your express permission.



We do reserve the right to permit your adviser, assessors and any consultant in the assessment process (and the appeal process, if applicable) to read and analyze your submission, but only for the task of evaluation. At no time will your material be made available to anyone outside the credentialing process.

My English language skills aren't great. Can I still take the program?

The ChBC™ designation is available to people around the world, and as much as possible we try to support candidates whose first language is not English. However, your learning adviser will be working with you in English. It's your responsibility to make sure you can communicate clearly with your adviser, in writing and in speech, so that you can take full advantage of the guidance offered. If your English skills are not strong, we urge you to get a translator or similar support.

What's the refund policy?

Once you've submitted your application and payment, if you're not accepted into the program—most likely because you don't meet the eligibility requirements—your payment will be refunded, minus a £50 administrative fee.

Once you've paid and been accepted (i.e., issued an online password), you are enrolled in the program, and as with all academic and professional programs, the full fee is generally non-refundable.

After you're enrolled, you will receive a 75% refund within the first month if it's clear that you haven't used the program resources (e.g., learning adviser, virtual learning environment).

From that point on, withdrawal requests will be considered fairly but with no guarantees. Internal guidelines are to refund up to 50% of your fee before any portfolio elements are sent to your adviser, and 25% before your first assessment. If you decide to leave the program before completing it, you must inform PDF by email: enquiries@pdf.net.

What if I have a grievance or want to appeal the decision?

If you're dissatisfied with how your assessment was conducted, or you feel your case wasn't treated fairly, reasonably and transparently, you have recourse to our grievance, dispute and appeal procedure.

Write to the Director of PDF, identifying the cause of your dissatisfaction and giving a full history of your submission. The Director and the supervising PDF faculty will review how the assessment was conducted and will contact your adviser and assessors to learn more. PDF will then inform you of the conclusions of its deliberation and, where appropriate, recommend a remedy.



Fees

The one-time fee of £5200 covers all costs leading to the ChBC™ designation: materials, learning adviser, online learning environment, assessments, use of normal resources and the designation certificate.

Re-certification every five years carries an additional nominal fee (approximately £150).

Annual WABC membership fees are not included in these fees.
